

340.0011 PARKING DURING AND AFTER SNOW STORMS. (a) The Village Board declares that an emergency exists during and following a snow storm until the snow from the storm has been removed from the streets of the village; therefore the regulations of this section shall be controlling over any other ordinance which might be in any way conflicting.

(b) No person shall park or leave standing any vehicle on any street in the village after a snowfall of at least one inch in depth until the snow from such street has been removed or plowed completely therefrom. A snowfall of at least one inch in depth shall be deemed to create a snow emergency.

The requirements of this section shall in addition to being published in the official newspaper for the village, be also posted by the erection of permanent signs placed at the various entrances to the village reading as follows:

"Snow Ordinance in Effect  
Contact Local Police"

In case any vehicles are parked or left standing on any street in violation of this section, they shall be removed by or under the direction of the Village President after a reasonable effort has been made to notify the owner to remove such vehicle and it has not been removed. In case such vehicle is removed by or at the direction of the Village President, the expense of such removal shall be charged against the owner of the vehicle. The removal of a car by or under the direction of the Village President shall not prevent prosecution for a violation of this section. (98) (2/6/75)

340.0012 PARKING FORFEITURES. (a) Standard Forfeiture, Parking Violations. Any person who violates any of the provisions of the nonmoving traffic ordinances of the Village of Footville shall upon conviction thereof pay a forfeiture of not less than \$4 nor more than \$15, together with the costs of prosecution and in default of payment such person shall be imprisoned in the County Jail not to exceed three days.

(b) Stipulation of Guilt in Lieu of Prosecution. If a stipulation of guilt is filed within five days of the offense and the amount of the forfeiture indicated on the citation paid to the Police Department office in the Village Hall, no costs of prosecution shall be added. The amount to be paid to the Police Department office shall be \$4 for the first offense. An additional \$2 shall be added to the amount collected for each subsequent offense within one year, not to exceed an overall total of \$10 for any one offense.
